6 Mod rules of play for U-6

7 Law I - The Field

8 A. Dimensions:

9 The field of play shall be rectangular, its length being 30 yards and its width 20 yards.

10 B. Markings:

- 11 1. Distinctive lines not more than four (4) inches wide.
12 2. A halfway line shall be marked out across the field.
13 3. A center circle with a six (6) yard diameter.
14 4. Four corner arcs with a two (2) foot radius.
15 5. Goal area, two (2) yards from each goal post and two (2) yards into the field joined by a
16 line drawn parallel with the goal line.

17 C. Goals:

- 18 1. Maximum size: Four (4) feet high and six (6) feet wide.
19 2. Goals must be anchored. Stacked or weighted methods are acceptable.
20 3. If no traditional goals are available cones or flags may be used. {Rule 302.1 (b)}

21 LAW II - THE BALL: Size three (3).

22 LAW III - NUMBER OF PLAYERS:

- 23 A. Maximum number of players on the field at any one time is three (3).
24 B. **There are no goalkeepers. There should be no defenders inside the goal box without an**
25 **offensive player within the vicinity. Players are not allowed to “camp out” in front of the goal.**
26 C. Maximum number of players on the roster should not exceed six (6).
27 D. Substitutions:
28 1. May be made, with the consent of the referee, during any stoppage of play.
29 E. Playing time: Each player SHALL play a minimum of 50% of the total playing time.
30 F. Spectators and players not on the field of play must remain two (2) yards behind the touchline
31 and not within the distance of the goal/penalty area.

32 LAW IV - PLAYERS EQUIPMENT:

33 Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

- 34 A. Footwear: Tennis/gym shoes or soft cleated shoes.
35 B. Shin guards: Mandatory. With socks up and over the top of the shin guards.

- 36 C. In case of color clash, the designated home team will change jerseys.
- 37 D. Jewelry and hair pieces that can harm the player or an opponent are not allowed.
- 38 E. In general, certain items are not allowed to be worn, like casts, splints/braces, rings, necklaces,
39 bracelets, earrings, hard-billed hats, and other articles of clothing deemed to be hazardous by
40 the referee.

41 **LAW V - REFEREE;**

- 42 A. Acceptable Referees:
- 43 2. Registered Referee.
- 44 3. Associate Referees.
- 45 4. Parent/Coach or Assistant Coach.
- 46 B. Referee Actions
- 47 1. Referee's decisions on points of fact connected with the game shall be final.
- 48 2. All rule infractions shall be briefly explained to the offending player.

49 **LAW VI - LINESMEN:** No Assistant Referees are used.

50 **LAW VII - DURATION OF GAME:**

- 51 A. The game shall be divided into three (3) equal periods of ten (10) minutes each.
- 52 B. The first two periods will be followed by a five (5) minute break.
- 53 C. Teams will not switch ends at any point.

54 **LAW VIII - THE START OF PLAY:**

55 Conform to FIFA with the following exception:

- 56 A. Opponents must be six (6) yards from the center mark while place kick is in progress.
- 57 B. Drop kicking and punting are not allowed.

58 **LAW IX - BALL IN And OUT OF PLAY:** Conform to FIFA.

59 **LAW X - METHOD OF SCORING:** No score keeping.

60 **LAW XI - OFFSIDE:** The offside rule will not be enforced.

61 **LAW XII - FOULS AND MISCONDUCT:**

62 Conform to FIFA with the following exception:

- 63 A. No caution or ejections shall be issued to players except by an independent neutral Referee.
- 64 B. NO SLIDE TACKLING IS ALLOWED
- 65 C. All fouls and restarts are indirect. {Rule 302.9 (f)(2)}
